

Origami Bat Tutorial



A SIMPLE CELEBRATIONS RESOURCE
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Materials

These are so simple all you need is a square of kite or origami paper and a pair of scissors! We used purple and brown but feel free to choose any colour. We created a moon out of golden yellow kite paper to add to our window scene.





Take your square and fold it into a triangle.



Fold it in half again



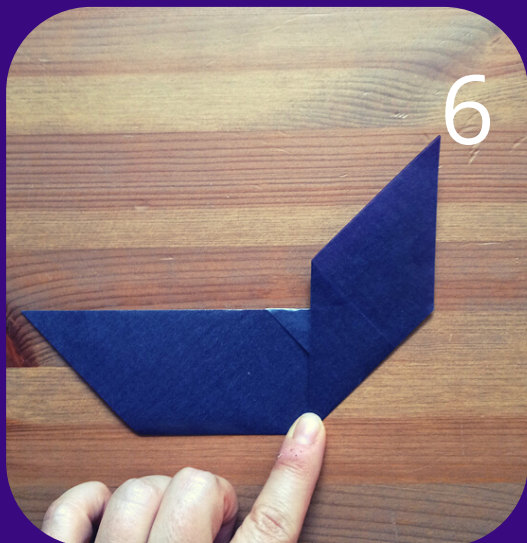
Open to fold up to reveal the center crease.



Take the bottom and fold it up towards the top, leaving about 1.5cm for the ears.



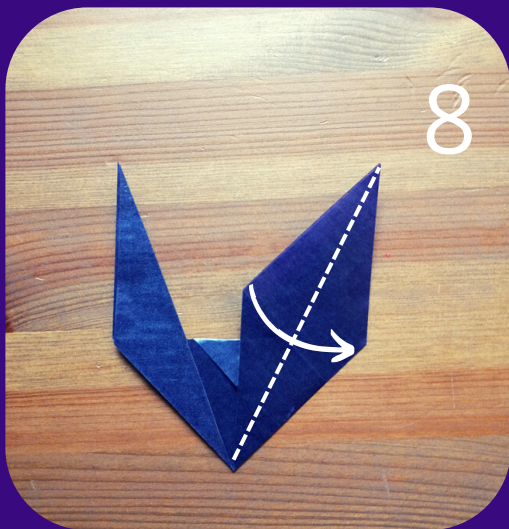
Fold the ears down.



Fold the side up along the center line.



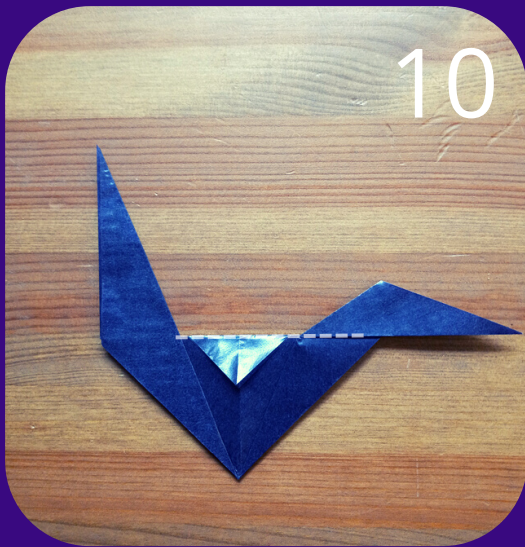
Repeat on the other side.
You'll have two diamond
shapes now.



Fold each of these
diamonds in half towards
their outer most points.



Our bat is taking shape!

Fold the wing to sit across the top of the body.

Do the same with the other wing.

Fold the ears back up and cut down the center line.



Take each ear and fold down to sit on top of body line.



And that's your bat! You could add a face if you wanted the extra detail.

Make as many as you like
and create a garland or
window scene of your own!
